



Pawcific Dog Park Rules & Regulations

Membership

- Pawcific Dog Park is a member-only, off-leash dog park.
- Memberships must be obtained at the Community Center.
- All members must display their Park District tag while in the park.

General Use

- Pawcific Dog Park is open sunrise to sunset.
- Members are responsible for their dogs' actions.
- Members use the park at their own risk.
- Alcoholic beverages and smoking are not permitted.
- Dogs must be leashed while entering and exiting the park. Once in the dog park run area, the leash may be removed.
- Keep an eye on your dog and always keep your dog's leash with you.
- Leash your dog immediately if aggressive behavior is observed.
- Members are asked to closely supervise their dogs and at no time should anyone leave the area without their dog(s).
- Children under 10 are not permitted in the dog park at any time.
- Children ages 10–17 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older.
- Children must behave appropriately: no running, chasing dogs, or petting other dogs without the owner's permission.

Dog Requirements

- Dogs visiting the park must be at least 4 months old.
- Dogs must wear a current license tag and be up-to-date on vaccinations.
- Dogs that are ill or in heat are not permitted.
- Dogs known to be aggressive toward other dogs or people may not enter the area.
- Dogs infected with any contagious disease are prohibited from the dog park.
- No more than 2 dogs per person on any one visit.

Park Etiquette

- Be polite: pick up dog feces and dispose of it in waste receptacles provided.
- Cover any holes your dog digs.
- Rawhide, food, and toys are not allowed in the dog park, as dog fights may result.
